District 6 wins trophy at Fall Board Meeting

About 40 members from around the state attended the 103rd TFMC Fall Board Meeting Aug. 18-19 in Dallas.

For the second year in a row, the prestigious Ruth Humphrey Community Service Award went to District 6, accepted by Mary Thomason, president. The award is earned by member participation in music service in the community and choral activities

This meeting was the first for Lois Armor, who assumed the office of TFMC president July 1. Special entertainment at the Friday night dinner was provided by Amanda O'Toole, who sang at Opera in the Ozarks in the summer. She is pursuing her master's in Vocal Performance at the University of North Texas.

At OIO this past summer, she sang the title role in <u>Carmen</u> by Georges Bizet. She received scholarship assistance from TFMC and the late Gloria Thrasher. Various workshops, business items and musical interludes took place during the two days of meeting.

Lois led the Texas delegation to Opera in the Ozarks in July and to the Governing Board meeting in November. She also attended the NFMC convention in Dayton, Ohio in June, which was the final time for Lynn McNew to march in the parade of presidents for Texas.

"Giving Tuesday" has replaced "ArkansasGives" as an online way to support Opera in the Ozarks. It will happen Nov. 28, the first Tuesday after Thanksgiving.

Log onto the OIO website, which is www.opera.org, and click the "Support Us" button. You can pledge any amount, but a \$25 minimum is suggested. Your contribution is safe and is tax-deductible.

We also hope you are contributing to the OIO Annual Fund, which began Oct. 1 and continues until Dec. 31. We are trying to meet a Challenge Grant of \$50,000.

Reminder to Club presidents, Treasurers -- deadline looms

Dues notices for July 1, 2017/June 30, 2018 were sent to all clubs in September and are due to TFMC Treasurer Dorene Allen by November 15 so that she can meet the December 1 deadline required by NFMC.

Senior Clubs must send a list of all club members, Life members, name and addresses for the mailout of the Music Club Magazine from National. Please consider the Founder's Day contribution (\$1) per capita, and the Past President (PPA) dues (\$2) for each term served as president of club, district, or state, and any contribution for state or national. This goes to the Young Artist Fund. (As a reminder-All contributions going to national should be given though the state treasurer so Texas FMCs will receive the credit and recognition.)

Clubs have been asked to send \$5 per year to the ONP (outgoing national president fund, formerly PNP) to endow the scholarship fund of Michael Edwards, NFMC President at the conclusion of his term in 2019.


